The Community Services Support Foundation adheres to the Association of Fundraising Professionals (AFP) Code of Ethical Principles and Standards, Values, and Donor Bill of Rights. Ethical standards and principles are the foundation for maintaining public trust in our nonprofit organization. Adhering to ethical standards in fundraising is especially important because the success of our organization's mission rests on trust: the trust of volunteers, donors, and the community served. The AFP Code of Ethics and the Donor Bill of Rights are the foundation for all fundraising activity in the United States. They provide a structure that fundraisers can use to help guide them as they take what can frequently be difficult decisions about the nature of their day-to-day practice. The AFP Code of Ethical Principles and Standards is grounded in a set of values that fundraisers aspire to honor in their lives and work.
